

4TH ANNUAL OREGON STATE POLICE GOLF TOURNAMENT

CREEKSIDE GOLF CLUB

JUNE 30, 2023

Format: This is a 4-person scramble No handicaps are required.

Rules of play:

- Teams may consist of all male, all female or a mixture.
Men under 65yrs will hit from the white tees.
Men 66yrs and over may hit from the gold tees.
Women may hit from the forward gold or maroon tees, however, they must maintain the same color tees throughout the match.
- All team members tee off on each hole and select the ball location for the second shot. All team members hit the second shot from the same spot. This procedure is followed on every shot until a putt is made.
- Team will record one score for each hole.
- Each team member must have a minimum of two drives.
- You may lift, clean, and place your ball within one club length. You may not move the ball out of a hazard (including bunkers), out of the rough, from the fairway or rough to the apron, or from the apron to the green. In other words, play it where it lies within one club length.
- Ball is marked on the green and putts need to be placed within 3 inches of the marked spot (no closer to the hole).
- Teams with only 3 members. Each team member in rotation may hit 4th ball.
- All putts must be holed. No "gimmie" putts.
- Turn score card into the pro shop.

Prizes:

- Teams will be broken into two flights. Prizes will be awarded for first through third place in each flight.
- Prizes for closest to the pin on Holes 6 and 14; closest drive to the line on hole 12; and the most lost balls.
- Putting contest.
- Raffle and silent auction to follow

Creekside Golf Etiquette

- GOLF CARTS MUST REMAIN ON CART PATH ON ALL PAR 3'S.
- ON HOLE #16 GOLF CARTS MUST REMAIN ON CART PATH UNTIL PASSED THE YELLOW TEE BOX.
- All alcohol must be bought at the golf club.

- Replace and/or repair all divots. Each cart is equipped with sand.
- Repair ball marks on the green.
- Blue topped stakes are environmentally protected areas. No entry for any reason.
