Our Cause

Thank you for considering sponsoring the 2024 Cure Kinley & Kennedy Golf Tournament!

In the summer of 2020, we received an unimaginable and unexpected diagnosis for our two daughters, Kinley & Kennedy. After years of pursuing answers for unexplained delays and health issues, our fears were confirmed when genetic testing showed both girls have GM1 Gangliosidosis Type II—an ultra-rare neurodegenerative disease with no treatment or cure. Adding to the pain, the disease is fatal, with life expectancy between mid-teens and late twenties and with a declining quality of life. Our girls will slowly regress in their development and eventually lose their ability to walk, talk, and eat, and it will ultimately take their lives.



Kinley will be 11 in June and has the kindest heart. She has lost much of her ability to speak clearly and uses an assistive speech device throughout the day. Over the last year, her ability to walk, especially long distances, has also declined, and she is starting to complain of knee and hip pain. While she doesn't require a full-time wheelchair yet, we do use one for her when we're out adventuring!



Kennedy is 8 and is the undisputed diva (and drama queen) of the family. As with her sister, GM1 has started taking hold of her ability to speak. We can't understand her as much as last year, so she also uses an assistive speech device when needed. Kennedy is also dealing with the reality of physical regression, which can lead to her getting into binds where she can climb onto things but can't get down.

Since diagnosis, we have been on a mission to bring awareness to GM1 and other rare diseases. Given the limited population, very little attention and funding is given to rare diseases. Yet thousands of families are having the same experience we are having—a fatal diagnosis with very few prospects for treatment or hope for a cure before it is too late.

While there were several promising critical trials underway (of which Kinley and Kennedy were part), all but one were sadly discontinued in 2023. The salt in the wound with this news is that the decisions were made primarily because of financial constraints, not poor outlooks on the treatment. This is why we need YOU!


