ABOUT HDS FOUNDATION



501(c)(3) Non-profit

In 2008, Cristina Miranda Gilson founded the HDS Foundation, a 501(c)(3) Non-Profit, to address the emerging needs of the Autism population. The foundation focuses on mentoring, job skills training, internships, and, ultimately, developing housing models for young adults on the Autism Spectrum.

Our organization's primary goal is to support students with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) in developing social and independent living skills, preparing for post-high school life, and achieving success in post-secondary education and careers. We also aim to provide information on safe and Affordable Housing options.

Over the past decade, the HDS Foundation has awarded grants for programs meeting our criteria. Our Program Managers work with schools, teachers, and students to facilitate career fairs and community-based instruction experiences. Grant funds cover these activities ensuring that each student and their families incur no cost.

Our impact is evident through the exposure the students receive learning and practicing life skills each week during their Community Based Instruction field trips. We also offer support to families by providing resources that will help them plan for their child's post-secondary journey.

Our programs aim to foster personal growth and independence:

HDS B.R.I.D.G.E.S. Program:

- Supports year-round programs for ASD high school students, incorporating communitybased field trips and life skills initiatives.
- Builds communication tools, peer mentoring, and friendships, preparing students for life after high school.

Social Activities Program (S.A.P.):

• Enhances the lives of teens and young adults transitioning to post-secondary education through positive social interactions.

HDS College Mentors Program:

- Identifies peripheral needs of students with Autism Spectrum Disorder pursuing a college degree.
- Focuses on guidance and support for academic success, as well as social and interpersonal skills.

ASDY-TECH Employment Training and Mentoring Program:

- Provides employment opportunities for young adults on the Autism Spectrum.
- Focuses on technical projects scalable to meet the employment needs of the ASD population while serving clients' service needs.
