## **Donation Tournament Bag Contents**

### Mulligans (Do Over)

(1 blue ticket)

Take a bad shot? Put the ball back on the tee (or more commonly set the ball back down on the green) and try again. May only be used once, please discard once used. It may be used by anyone on the team, does not have to be one ticket per person, team decision who and when the tickets are used.

#### **Grenade Balls**

These can be thrown, instead of hitting with a club, allowing better accuracy and an interesting spectacle on the course! The grenade ball does NOT count as a stroke. Once a ball has been used it must be discarded and not used again.

### String it Out

This string may be used during play to improve a player's lie or even void a stroke. At any point, a player may move the ball the length of the string provided to any desired position. You may use the four pieces at the same time or individually, but once you have used the string it must be discarded and not used again during the round.

# Firebirds on the Fairway

### Format: 4 Person Scramble

Men: White tees Women: Red Tees

All players tee off, pick the best shot-all players play the second shot from that point. All balls can be placed. Continue this process until the ball is holed. You may move the ball one club length, no closer to the hole and you may not improve your lie. Ex: out of sand or onto the green.

Please remember pace of play and do not look for lost balls - this is a scramble format. Pace of your round should be no more than 4½ hours.

Please stay on cartpath around all greens, tee boxes and all par threes.
