



2026 Charity Golf Tournament Rules and Info

Northshore Country Club Friday May 15th, 2026

- Check-In
 - Team check in will be done in the Northshore Country Club Ball Room at 7 am. Here, you will check in your team.
 - Breakfast tacos will be provided in the Ball Room, along with Swag Bags.
- Mulligans / Tiger Tee
 - During online sign up or during team check-in, you will be able to purchase the following:
 - Up to 10 extra Mulligans per team (\$10 each). They are to be split evenly between your teammates. Your team is given 4 free mulligans total just for participating.
 - Tiger Tee for Hole #6 (\$40 per team).
- Announcements:
 - Announcements will be made from the PA system at 730 am. They will go over rules and will also specify what hole your team will start at. Once announcements are made, all teams will be released to their designated start hole.
- Teams:
 - Due to the number of teams, some teams will be on the 1st flight or 2nd flight. Meaning the 1st flight team will begin first at that hole. The 2nd flight team will tee off once the 1st team is within safe distance. This information will be relayed to your team during team check-in and during announcements.
 - All carts will have company names and player names on signs. Use only the carts assigned to your team / players. Score cards will be on the carts.
- Tournament Play and Information:
 - All players will be playing from the White tees, unless you are a senior or a woman. Gold for seniors and Red for women.
 - Tournament is being played best ball and par is your friend. No teams will have an over par score on any hole.
 - Scorecards shall specify their company's name and if applicable, team 1 or 2. They shall also have the name of every player on the team.
 - Once your team is finished with all 18 holes, a representative from your team will be required to turn in your team's final score card to the pro shop. Only one score card per team is to be turned in.
 - Players can only use the number of mulligans that were purchased (online or during check-in).
 - In the case of a tie, a score card playoff will be used in lieu of a physical playoff.
- Hole Assignments:
 - Golf Cannon - Hole 5
 - \$20 each to shoot your golf ball out of our Golf Cannon. Payment for this will be taken at hole 5 by Mully Golf. All proceeds go to Battlin' BBQ.

- Tiger Tee - Hole 6
 - For teams that purchase the Tiger tee, their team will be able to tee off from the Tiger Tee sign that is in the fairway, 150 yards from the green. Teeing off at the Tiger Tee counts as your 2nd shot.
- Closest to the Pin - Hole 13
 - If your ball stops closer than where the closest to the pin sign is, you will write your name down on the sign provided and move it to your spot.
- Men's Longest Drive - Hole 18
 - If your ball stops further than where the Longest Drive sign is, you will write your name down on the sign provided and move it to your spot. Drive must be in fairway to qualify.
- Women's Longest Drive – Hole 1
 - If your ball stops further than where the Longest Drive sign is, you will write your name down on the sign provided and move it to your spot. Drive must be in fairway to qualify.
- 12:30 Lunch / Awards / Raffle:
 - Complementary lunch will be provided for all tournament players in the Ball Room.
 - Awards will also be held in the Ball Room, once all scores are tallied. The awards presented are:
 - 1st place team awards
 - 2nd place team awards
 - 3rd place team awards
 - Men's Longest Drive
 - Women's Longest Drive
 - Closest to the Pin
 - Raffle Drawing
- 2:30 Doubles Cornhole Tournament
 - A double elimination Doubles Cornhole Tournament will take place in the Ball Room. Entry is \$40 per team. Awards will be given to 1st and 2nd place.
