



- ❖ **What time does registration begin the day of the event?**
 - Registration/pre-round meals begin approximately 1.5 hours before the start time of the shotgun. For example, a noon shotgun means registration would begin at 10:30am. Practice facility opening times are in concurrence with this timeline.

- ❖ **What is the difference between Wissahickon & Militia Hill?**
 - The primary difference between the two is the modes of transportation. Players on Wissahickon will be walking with caddies and players on Militia Hill will be riding in carts with forecaddies. To take a cart on Wissahickon, the player must be over 65 or have a medical note provided in advance.

- ❖ **What address should I use when providing directions?**
 - The Philadelphia Cricket Club has multiple campuses but players playing in a golf outing will park at 401 Stenton Avenue. All staging of the event will be held at the Militia Hill Clubhouse.

- ❖ **Does PCC provide rental clubs?**
 - Yes, PCC has a robust supply of rental clubs available. Players can let us know the day of if they require one, but any advanced notice would be appreciated. These sets are on a first come, first served basis and cost \$60 plus tax for the day. These sets can be billed to the outing or paid for by the individual using them.

- ❖ **Does PCC have an ATM?**
 - There is no ATM on the property. Players are encouraged to bring cash with them to handle caddy payment/tipping/etc.

- ❖ **Can players make purchases in the golf shop?**
 - Yes! All merchandise in the golf shop can be purchased via credit card or cash. The golf shop cannot accommodate interclub billing.

- ❖ **Is there a place where players can store items?**
 - The locker room will be available to all the players. A staff member will be in the locker room to assist participants. Players can store shoes or a change of clothes in a locker while they are out on the golf course. Showers are also available for use. Locker rooms will be available for both men and women.



Militia Hill Clubhouse Notes (2026)

Below are the key differences from previous years given construction on the Wissahickon clubhouse:

❖ Parking

- The Militia Hill parking lot is larger than the Wissahickon parking lot. Participants can park on a first come first serve basis and are encouraged to use the bag drop prior to parking their vehicles. All overflow parking will be relegated to the driveway coming into the clubhouse. It is highly recommended that, if possible, volunteers are present to help keep parking organized. PCC staff will also be present to assist. Carpooling is still strongly encouraged if possible.

❖ Address/Directions

- Outing participants should be instructed to park at the Militia Hill Clubhouse (401 Stenton Avenue) regardless of which golf course they are playing. Additional roadside signage will be present day to help assist people locate the driveway into the clubhouse.

❖ Locker Rooms

- The Locker Room at Wissahickon will still be open and available for participants to use. Shuttles/golf carts will be available for those wishing to drive to Wissahickon. The Militia Hill clubhouse has space for men and women to change shoes/clothes. We highly recommend participants store items in their vehicles that they are not planning on using throughout the day.

❖ Cart/Bag Staging

- All golf carts will be staged with players' names included on the cart, so participants know where to go to find their bag. The golf staff will assist with directing players and handling their golf bags.
- Players playing Wissahickon will be given a golf cart to drive out to their starting holes. Caddies in the group will be the guide for directing players to holes. Caddies may NOT ride on the back of a golf cart – they should ride inside the cart with the players. Once players on Wissahickon arrive to their starting hole, they will park their golf cart and walk the round with their caddies. Upon completion of the round, they will take those same carts back to the Militia Hill Clubhouse. Only players 65+ and/or players with a medical note can use carts on Wissahickon.



- Players playing Militia Hill will have the use of golf carts the entire round. They will drive out to their starting holes with their forecaddie. This process is the exact same as years past.

- ❖ **Practice Facility**
 - The newly renovated practice facilities will be available for all outing participants prior to the shotgun start time. The range will utilize mats. The shortgame area is closed on Mondays.

- ❖ **Golf Shop**
 - The Wissahickon golf shop will be open and fully stocked for outing participants. Players can use their golf carts to get to and from the Wissahickon shop if they choose to purchase merchandise. There will also be a golf shop at Militia Hill with similar offerings at the Wissahickon shop.
 - The closure of the shop will be approximately 45-60 minutes after results/prizes have been awarded.

- ❖ **On-Course/Round of Golf**
 - The on-course experience for golfers will be the exact same as prior years.
